## 2021-0010: Appropriations Prize and Merchandise Funding

Recognizing that multiple student organizations want to host virtual events this year but are having difficulty getting students to attend,

Recognizing that the virtual semester has made members of student organizations feel less involved and disconnected from the campus community,

Drawing attention to many student organizations who want to send gifts to their members in order to keep them engaged and to feel connected during a virtual semester,

It is resolved that the Allocations Handbook will include these resolutions for the 2020-2021 Academic School Year to support all student organizations with their financial needs,

It is resolved that the following will be added as Article VI Section B Subsection b Sub-Subsection iii Sub-Sub-Subsection g of the SGC Allocations Handbook:

g. SGC will fund merchandise for student organizations if the merchandise aligns with the organization’s mission statement and serves a purpose that would benefit all the members in the organization.

It is resolved that the following will be added as Article VI Section C Subsection b Sub-Subsection i Sub-Sub-Subsection d of the SGC Allocations Handbook:

d. SGC will fund prizes for programming events, as long as all event attendees are eligible to win the prizes. The total amount funded for prizes shall not exceed \$50 times the number of hosting organizations, with a maximum of \$200 to be allocated for prizes.
