*Recognizing* that the SGC Allocations Handbook does not contain directives for student organizations regarding having a designated health & safety officer in order to receive funding from the Appropriations Committee,

*Recognizing* that the SGC Allocations Handbook does not contain directives for student organizations requiring their compliance with the Office of Student Engagement and Ithaca College's health/community guidelines, in order to receive funding,

*Drawing attention to* the Office of Student Engagement's 2020-2021 Student Organization Guidebook that states "Organizations are required to determine a health & safety officer during recognition. This person holds ultimate responsibility for oversight for events.",

*It is resolved that* the following will be added as Article VI Section C Subsection B Sub-Subsection i Sub-Sub-Subsection d in the SGC Allocations Handbook:

d. It is required that all student organizations have a health & safety officer, and guarantee that their program is compliant with all the health/community guidelines for in-person events as established by the Office of Student Engagement and Ithaca College.
