2021-0034: Appropriations Prize Amendment

Recognizing that multiple student organizations want to host virtual events this year but are having difficulty getting students to attend,

Recognizing that the virtual semester has made members of student organizations feel less involved and disconnected from the campus community,

Drawing attention to Article VI Section C Subsection b Sub-Subsection i Sub-Sub-Subsection d of the SGC Allocations Handbook:

d. SGC will fund prizes for programming events, as long as all event attendees are eligible to win the prizes. The total amount funded for prizes shall not exceed \$50 times the number of hosting organizations, with a maximum of \$200 to be allocated for prizes.

It is resolved that the Allocations Handbook will amend the resolution for the 2020-2021 Academic School Year to support all student organizations with their financial needs,
