2021-0027: Meeting Procedure Adjournment Clarification Amendment

Drawing attention to the Preamble of the SGC Constitution, "The Student Governance Council serves as the only recognized representative body for the entire student community"

Recognizing that the SGC Meeting Procedures Act does not acknowledge an end time for weekly Senate Meetings or clear procedures for adjournment.

It is resolved that the following shall replace Article VII of the SGC Meeting Procedures Act:

ARTICLE VII: Adjournment

Section 1: At the end of the meeting, the Senate Chair will look upon a motion to adjourn. Once the motion is made, if there is no dissent of the Senate, the meeting is adjourned.

Section 2: Early Adjournment

1. A Senator may, at any time in the meeting, motion for a vote of adjournment.
 - a. If this motion is made during the presentation or discussion of an initiative, the Senate may make one vote to immediately table the initiative and subsequently adjourn.
2. At the two-hour mark post the beginning of the Senate meeting, the Senate Chair must announce to the Senate that the meeting has run for two hours and provide an opportunity for a Senator to make a motion of adjournment.
 - a. The Senate Chair will wait until the end of the present point of business to make this announcement.
