## 2021-0043: Bill Follow-Up Timeline Amendment

Sponsored by: Murtha  
Co-Sponsored by: Kurtz

Whereas there is no current timeline for the finalization of bills once approved by the Senate,

Recognizing this vagueness has created issues for both updating organizational records as well as providing updates and follow-through to the campus community,

Recognizing that without this update, bills are not counted as being finalized,

Understanding the importance of timeliness in updating and providing bills for the campus community to view,

**It is resolved that** the following changes to organizational documents take place in order to ensure a timeline is followed for every bill approved by the Senate:

### Section 1. The Constitution

1. Article IV, Section 10, Sub-Section 2, Sub-Sub-Section c shall be added to state:  
“Following the approval of a bill, a sponsor must update and send the bill to the President, Senate Chair, Chief of Staff, and Website Manager within one week of passing in accordance with the Meeting Procedures Act.”

### Section 2. Meeting Procedures Act

1. Article II, Section 4, Sub-Section 5, Sub-Sub-Section a shall be updated to read:  
“If approved, the sponsor(s) of the bill shall send a final copy of the bill (with

all its edits and proper information: updating date of presentation, bill number, and final vote) to the President, Senate Chair, Chief of Staff, and Website Manager. This final copy shall be sent within one week of passing.”
