Whereas, the role of Student Government Association is to act on behalf of the student body.

Whereas, Student Government Association allocates a significant amount of money for student organizations to put on events.

Whereas, Student Government Association represents the views of the students in the numerous organizations on campus.

It is resolved that members of the Student Government Association, including the Senate Body, the Executive Board, and ex-^{E-board}efficio members of the Senate, shall participate in five (5) student organization events and/or club meetings per semester.

In addition, be it further resolved that the Vice President of Senate Affairs will compile an up-to-date list of events that will be taking place on campus that will be uploaded to the SGA website.

In addition, be it further resolved that senators will tell the Vice President of Senate affairs which events were attended for the semester. Senate members will be held to the honor code in telling the Vice President of Senate Affairs which events were attended. All Senate members are held to the standard of the Ithaca College Student Conduct Code.

In addition, be it further resolved that in accordance to the date of the event, members of SGA must announce what event they attended and their thoughts at the following SGA weekly meeting. The Vice President of Senate Affairs will be responsible for records of events attended.

In addition, be it further resolved that Senators will fill the Senate in on the events they attended during open agenda.

In addition, be it further resolved that senators who fail to adhere to this policy will receive an "absence" mark on their attendance for every one (1) event missed in a semester.
