Whereas, most, if not all humans need food to survive,

Whereas, Ithaca College invites students on campus (specifically those living in apartments) to move in well over a week prior to the first day of classes (8/17),

Whereas, this year, meal plans do not go into effect until one week after the date in which students were welcomed to check into their apartments (8/24),

Whereas, students living in apartments who depend on a meal plan move in early are left with very minimal options to obtain food, other than to order out,

Whereas, Ithaca College caters to a very small number of students such as international students over extended breaks such as Winter Break,

Whereas, it should be Ithaca College's responsibility to offer food options at all normal times of the day (Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner) while being advertised as opened

It is resolved that, the Ithaca College Student Government Association formally recommends to Dining Services to coordinate with the institution when students' meal plans go into effect in conjunction with when students are allowed to move in, or provide a disclaimer to better communicate when meal plans go into effect.
