

**Whereas**, at any point during discussion of a bill or amendment, a Senator within the Ithaca College Student Government Association can motion to make an amendment to said bill or amendment,

**Whereas**, if a Senator makes a successful motion to amend, there is then no time limit restricting the amount of conversation regarding a respective amendment,

**Whereas**, it would be more efficient for the bill and amendment process to limit the time for discussion on amending a bill or amendment,

**It is resolved that**, under Article IV, Section 11, as a sub-bullet under "New business..." to read, "If a motion successfully passed by a Senator to amend a bill or amendment, there shall be a ten (10) minute discussion on that respective amendment. A Senator may move to extend the time limit of discussion if need be before a respective vote on said amendment."
