


**Whereas**, for the 2014-2015 Academic Year, Ithaca College instituted a Printing Management Policy to encourage sustainability and reduce wasteful printing,

**Whereas**, students are provided with only \$10 every semester semester (Aug 11, 2014 - Jan 1, 2015 & Jan 2 - May 17, 2015) which is approximately 142 double-sided pages per semester

**Whereas**, students all across Ithaca College have to print hundreds of pages of paper for class reading material, assignments, and forms each semester.

**Whereas**, this policy as it stands now inhibits students' abilities to achieve academic success without adding an additional cost to an already expensive educational institution

**Whereas**, students across campus are extremely concerned and bothered about this policy

**Whereas**, this creates one less attractive feature to potential students and current students

**Whereas**, it is unfair to the overall student body that students with office jobs and who are in the Honors Program still receive free printing

**It is resolved that**, that the Ithaca College Student Government Association formally recommends to the Ithaca College Administration that this printing management policy is immediately reevaluated.

**It is further resolved that**, that the Ithaca College Student Government Association works with the Ithaca College Administration, Facility, and Staff Members to create a new Printing Management Policy.
