2425-0001: Solicitation Policy Changes

Recognizing that the Ithaca College Advertising and Solicitation Policy provides inflexible guidelines on communication with students and hours in which clubs can advertise to the general student body.

Recognizing that there are outdated terms and typographical errors in the current advertising and solicitation policy.

With support from The First-Generation Senator (Noeline Luyindula), Melody Harter, and Sybil Conrad.

It is resolved that the Student Governance Council Campus Affairs Committee proposes the following changes to the Ithaca College Advertising and Solicitation Policy:

1. Typographical Errors
 - a. The second #15 in section 2.12.2 of the policy be changed to #17.
 - b. Section 2.12.5 #1, “Candidates in elections for student organizations such as the Student Government Association, Residence Hall Association, or Senior Class will be permitted space outside the Terrace and Towers dining halls for the purpose of distributing campaign information during designated campaign periods” be changed to, “Candidates in elections for student organizations such as the **Student Governance Council**, Residence Hall Association, or Senior Class will be permitted space outside the Terrace and **Campus Center Dining Halls** for the purpose of distributing campaign information during designated campaign periods.”
2. Content/Structural Changes
 - a. Section 2.12.2 #15 (changing to #17): “Solicitation is permitted on campus only between 9 am and 3 pm” be changed to “Solicitation is permitted on campus only between 9 am and 8 pm.”
 - i. In completing the solicitation form on IC Engage, student organizations will be permitted a maximum of 5 days in a row to reserve tables in Campus Center.

- b. Section 2.12.2 #14 “Solicitors may not call out to others and may not approach and hand out flyers/advertisements to others (except as a planned part of an approved program), and must remain behind their table” be changed to “Solicitors may engage in polite conversations with others and move around their table, but are not permitted to hand out flyers/advertisements (except as part of an approved program) or disrupt the flow of traffic.”
